## ESNR Advanced Courses in Diagnostic and Functional Neuroradiology

The Course in Advanced Functional and Diagnostic Neuroradiology is based on five days of eight hours each.

#### Requirements:

- o Applicants must have attended a full ECNR cycle and be ESNR Certified as Fellow in Neuroradiology, or hold the Portuguese Specialization in Neuroradiology
- o The course is reserved to Full Members in good standing with ESNR fees.

#### **Programme:**

### **Fundamentals of Neuro-anatomy**

Every morning one hour is dedicated to CT and MR anatomy of the brain and spine:

First Day: morning **DIFFUSION**Second Day: morning **PERFUSION**Third Day: morning **SPECTROSCOPY**Fourth Day: morning **FUNCTIONAL MRI** 

Fifth Day: morning SPINE

 $I^{st} - 5^{th}$  day afternoons are dedicated to work in small groups with the following goals: Simple exercises to reinforce and extend the teaching of the formal lectures

"Hands on" practical applications on clinical cases (workstations)

"Meet the experts" discussion of data and experiments.

**Course examination:** at the end of the course there will be a self-assessment test consisting of multiple-choice questionnaires.

After attending the full Course on Advanced Diagnostic Neuroradiology, having passed the multiple choice test, and having spent one year in a neuroradiology centre active in this field, it will be possible, for ESNR Full Members, to sit the examination for the certification in:
